Art
Grades 6/7/8

The 6/7/8 Art program works with the concepts of depth and perspective through the use of varied drawing materials, tempera and watercolor paint, clay, collage, and papier mache. Using these media the students acquire skills for sculpting, drawing, painting, claywork, and 3-D materials. The students learn about the elements and principles of art, specific art terminology, art history and art of diverse cultures in relation to the work they are creating. They learn to critique their work and that of their classmates, as well as visiting museums and learning to look critically at different types of art from different genres and historical periods. Their work is exhibited in the halls throughout the year.
