Skills to be developed during the Pre K Four year are:

Language Arts:

- letter recognition
- name recognition
- writing of one's name
- speaking with complete sentences and thoughts
- answering different types of questions
- identifying labels in classroom
- listening during story time
- learning poems and songs with relative ease
- creative dramatic play
- beginning writing with letter-sound correspondence

Math:

- counting 1-10
- recognizing numbers 1-10
- beginning of one to one correspondence
- repeat as well as make own patterns
- sort
- classify
- shape recognition
- ordering
- greater understanding of weight, height, length

Science:

- orally making predictions
- orally making observations
- noticing change in science related activities
- increased knowledge of properties of solids, semi-solids and liquids

Social Studies:

- understanding of self in relationship to others in a child's environment

Art:

- competence with various art mediums
- experimentation with various mediums
- development of representational pictures

Physical Education:

- comfort and relative competence on playground equipment and gym equipment
